THE GEORGE W. KARPUS '68 SCHOLARSHIP



The Karpus Scholarship supports the best and brightest students from Chenango Forks High School and Greene Central High School in New York State who wish to pursue their undergraduate studies at St. Lawrence University.

The Scholarship was established at his alma mater in 2006 by George W. Karpus '68, an investor, entrepreneur, business owner, philanthropist, and founder of the Karpus Family Foundation. The Scholarship is awarded to students based on their high school grade point average (GPA) and helps to reduce the overall cost of attending St. Lawrence University.

The Scholarship will cover the following percentages of the student/family's share of the cost of attendance at St. Lawrence, after the student is accepted and the University has awarded a financial aid package consisting of a merit or specialty scholarship (if applicable), need-based grants, student loans, and/or work-study:

- 75% of the student/family's share, if the student's GPA ranges from 3.401 to 4.0
- 50% of the student/family's share, if the student's GPA ranges from 2.901 to 3.4
- 25% of the student/family's share, if the student's GPA ranges from 2.5 to 2.9

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- Be a graduating senior at Chenango Forks High School or Greene Central High School in New York State
- Be admitted to St. Lawrence University as a first-time, first-year college student
- Apply for need-based financial aid via the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and list St. Lawrence University to receive the results (our school code is 002829)
- Scholarship recipients must file the FAFSA each year to maintain their eligibility.

Application deadline for consideration for the Fall 2024 semester is February 1st, 2024.
